Sensitisation of clients and key stakeholders will be based on a Prescribed sensitization package on HIV Prevention that includes the following key areas: HIV Situation in Kenya; Basic Facts on HIV and AIDS; linkages between sexual and gender based violence and HIV; Adherence to HIV treatment and care; Linkages between HIV, TB and Human rights, Reduction of stigma and discrimination toward people living with HIV; Linkages between HIV, and NCDs and Demand creation for HIV prevention, care and support services.
